The Freaks Come Out At Night

Scripture: Acts 16:25-26 (NLT) , ²⁵ Around midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening. ²⁶ Suddenly, there was a massive earthquake, and the prison was shaken to its foundations. All the doors immediately flew open, and the chains of every prisoner fell off!"

What do God's Children do at midnight?

1. worship. Acts 16:25 (NLT), ²⁵ Around midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening
2. witness. Acts 16:27-32 (NLT), ²⁷ The jailer woke up to see the prison doors wide open. He assumed the prisoners had escaped, so he drew his sword to kill himself. ²⁸ But Paul shouted to him, "Stop! Don't kill yourself! We are all here!" ²⁹ The jailer called for lights and ran to the dungeon and fell down trembling before Paul and Silas. ³⁰ Then he brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" ³¹ They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved, along with everyone in your household." ³² And they shared the word of the Lord with him and with all who lived in his household.
3. win. Acts 16:33-35 (NLT), ³³ Even at that hour of the night, the jailer cared for them and washed their wounds. Then he and everyone in his household were immediately baptized. ³⁴ He brought them into his house and set a meal before them, and he and his entire household rejoiced because they all believed in God. ³⁵ The next morning the city officials sent the police to tell the jailer, "Let those men go!"
