### Lessons From A Storm

Scripture- Mark 4:35-41, "<sup>38</sup>And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish?"

#### Stages of a Christian's Storm

1. There is an assignment. - Mark 4:35, "<sup>35</sup>And the same day, when the even was come, he saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other side."
2. There is often an attack. - Mark 4:37, "<sup>37</sup>And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full."
3. There is usually an assumption. - Mark 4:38, "<sup>38</sup>And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish?"
4. There is always an assurance. Mark 4:39, "<sup>39</sup>And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm."<sup>40</sup> And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?<sup>41</sup> And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?"
